Matthew Thompson has held the position of the Master of the Royal Court since September 2013. Prior to that he was a lawyer involved in many different kinds of civil litigation disputes, initially as an English Solicitor for 4 years and then in Jersey from 1993 until 2013.

One of his responsibilities as Master of the Royal Court is to act as mediator for all disputed claims before the Petty Debts Court (currently with a jurisdiction of £30,000). Since April 2014 he has carried out over 400 mediations covering a wide range of disputes.
